- Be enrolled fulltime (12 or more credit hours or clock hour equivalent), or be enrolled part-time (6 or more credit hours or clock hour equivalent), if employed in manufacturing,
- Be interested in a manufacturing related career, and
- Be a resident of Kansas.

Scholarship recipients may reapply for the WMA scholarship in subsequent years and be considered with other applicants if they maintain a 3.0 or better GPA (grade point average) in their major field and an overall 2.5 GPA (grade point average). Scholarships may not be available for all returning students.
