The mission of Envision is to provide quality jobs & competitive career opportunities for people with vision loss & blindness. They were founded in 1931 as the Wichita Workshop & Training School for the Adult Blind. In 1948 their name changed to Kansas Foundation for the Blind, in 1986 was changed to Wichita Industries & Services for the Blind and in 1997 was changed to Envision.

Envision is now the largest employer of individuals who are blind or low vision in a 6-state region. They make more than 90 products that are used across the globe. They operate retail stores on 15 military bases.

Their vision rehabilitation services include counseling, training in use of optical devices, rehabilitation teaching & orientation and mobility training. They also produce radio, tv & newspaper advertising campaigns centered on healthy vision.
